EAST TIMOR CARPENTRY TRAINING

A health clinic is being built near the village of Era Ulo, about 2 hours from Dili in the central highlands, in the Emera District of Timor Leste (East Timor). The clinic will serve about 6,000 people from Era Ulo and 5 surrounding villages where at present no health clinic exists.

Rotary eClub One is working with the Rotary clubs of Dili and Darwin in the construction of the health clinic, using a mixture of local and western construction methods. Rotary eClub One is providing tools, and we are training local people as carpenters. This will enable the building's interior to be completed.

Once trained, the carpenters will have the necessary skills to complete this task and make a useful contribution elsewhere in the village. The local primary school requires major building work to restore two unusable classrooms.
